Experience 700 years of history at the double-moated 13th century castle, once the childhood home of Anne Boleyn. Discover magnificent award-winning gardens set in 125 acres, see the giant topiary chess set and the Pompelian Wall and classical statuary in the Italian garden. ## Wednesday 3rd October 9.30 -Marwell Zoo and Tropical House (£25 pp incl. entry\* and fare)

Explore the Zoo and get closer to the wonders of the natural world of hundreds of animals. Visit the new Tropical House, spanning two levels offering fantastic vantage points were you can see a diversity of wildlife and exotic plants in a tropical climate.
